I'm researching my ancestors and am looking for information about my great-great grandparents who came from Prussia, in a town that is now called Nowe but at the time was Neuenburg or

Simon Roberts: born 1849
Dora (Neuman) Roberts: born 1851

They married in Prussia approximately 1867 to 1871

Simon migrated to the United States June 22, 1881, leaving the Hamburg port on the Westphalia ship.

Dora's migration to the US is unknown.

While still in Germany/Prussia, they had a number of children, one of which was Esther. She married a man with the surname Schretter (or Shretter, Schroeder or other spellings possible). She had at least one child before immigrating to the US - that child may have been killed before Esther immigrated to the US.

I'm trying to find information about Simon and Dora's marriage, children born in Prussia, Esther's husband and child and any relatives that may have stayed in Prussia and may still be living today.
